- 4. Mr. Londot reported that Kayla Jones from the Licking County Auditor's office CAUV and AG District reported to him that posts in line fence are to be no more than 60' apart, and that you must be able to stand in the fence line and look to your right and left and see where the fence goes.
- 5. Lonnie Richardson reported that he has the Township's snow removal equipment ready for the winter weather.

1. The Board discussed the Township's railroad crossing signs. They will look into the issue to make sure they are in compliance with the new laws.
