Employee & Appointee Report & Instruction:

- 1. Mr. Coe reported that 13020 Hull Rd. was issued a permit to build a garage; and he received a call from Pyramid Network Services about the construction of a communication tower in the Township.
- 2. Mr. McDaniel reported that he checked roads, cleaned catch basin on Stickle Rd., and salted roads. He also reported that the trucks are working, he got two loads of #9 gravel, and he has more mowing to do along the Township's roads.

Old Business:

- 1. The Board discussed the bids for the Township's banking contract. Mr. Shaw explained that The Park National Bank's offer is 2.5% interest for one year, to be adjusted annually for a two year term. The Peoples Bank offer is 2.0% interest fixed for a two year term.
- 2. Resolution 22-28 Mr. Smith moved to accept the banking contract from The Peoples Bank. The contract is for a term of two years, with one account paying 2.0% fixed interest on 100% of the Township's funds on deposit for the term of the contract. Seconded by Mr. Stevenson. Vote: Mr. Smith, yes; Mr. Stevenson, yes. Motion carried.
- 3. The Board discussed the time and dates for regular meetings for 2023. The Board is leaning toward the 2nd and 4th Mondays of the month at 6:00 p.m.
- 4. The Board discussed the progress of the new Emergency Services District. Mr. Stevenson reported that all information is with the Licking County and Knox County prosecutors. The next step in the process will come from them.
