The Trustees discussed the pros and cons of forming this new government entity.

PROS: More control, faster response times, cross-trained employees, and all agree that it would be best for the residents that the Utica EMS and Utica Fire Department merge into one entity.

CONS: Forming a new government entity, possible increase in taxes by replacing the current levies, and possible increase in paid employees.

Mr. John Torrens suggested that one of the Townships take over both departments, forming a Township Fire Department.

Mr. Donald Robinson asked to see a 5-year plan for the proposed fire district, and said he was not for forming a new government entity.
