- 1. Road Superintendent Terry Banks was not present.
- 2. Zoning Inspector Jim Dickson was present to present the Board with the 4<sup>th</sup> quarter zoning bills and payments. Mr. Dickson asked the Board to consider increasing the zoning fees to better cover costs of operating the zoning department. The Board will look into the matter.
- 3. The Board reported that limbs on Wince and Ginger Hill Roads need to be trimmed back; there is a muffler on Horns Hill Road that needs picked up; and, the "Road Closed" sign on Horns Hill Road is missing.

#### Reports:

- 1. Mr. Stevenson reported that the grant planning for Weaver Road project has been submitted to the Licking County Engineer. They are waiting for a response from the engineer's office.
- 2. Mr. Stevenson reported that an exemption for the MS4 flood area on Dog Hollow Road has been submitted to the Ohio EPA.
- 3. The Board looked at Census boundary changes; no changes for the Township.

### Old Business:

- 1. The Board reported that the 3.0 mil renewal and .75 mil increase levy for the Township's road district was voted down.
- 2. The Board discussed placing a levy for the Township's road district on the May ballot. After much discussion, the Board agreed to place a 3.0 mil renewal (which will not increase the residents' taxes) on the May ballot.
- 3. Resolution 16-19 Mr. Stevenson moved to aske the Licking County Auditor for amounts generated by placing a 3.0 mil renewal levy, for Washington Township's road district, for a period of 5 years on the May ballot. Seconded by Mr. Smith. Vote: Mr. Stevenson, yes; Mr. Coad, yes; Mr. Smith, yes. Motion carried.

## New Business:

- 1. The Board looked at the contracts from the Utica Fire Department and Utica EMS for 2017.
- Resolution 16-20 Mr. Coad moved to accept the contract from the Utica Fire Department for fire
  protection for the year 2017. Seconded by Mr. Smith. Vote: Mr. Stevenson, yes; Mr. Coad, yes;
  Mr. Smith, yes. Motion carried.
- 3. Resolution 16-21 Mr. Smith moved to accept the contract from the Utica EMS for EMS services for the residents of Washington Township for the year 2017. Seconded by Mr. Coad. Vote: Mr. Stevenson, abstained; Mr. Coad, yes; Mr. Smith, yes. Motion carried.
