Possible Consideration for the 2020 Road Repair Project:

- 1. The Fiscal Officer reported that only one bid was received for the 2020 Road Repair Project from Small's Asphalt Paving, Inc. totalling \$310,485.55 for all parts of the project.
- 2. The Trustees inspected the bid and after much discussion decided to accept the bid.
- 3. Resolution 20-15 Mr. Smith moved to accept the bid from Small's Asphalt Paving, Inc. for the 2020 Road Repair Project on a per-unit basis as follows: Performance Bond = \$1,700.00; Base Asphalt = \$71.20 per ton; tack coat furnished and applied = \$2.50 per gal.; 411 limestone berm = \$44.10 per ton; MC-3000, per Washington Township spec. = \$2.50 per gal.; #8 limestone sealing, per Washington Township spec. = \$32.50 per ton; 441-1 asphalt concrete surface course = \$65.25 per ton; 4" shallow pipe underdrain = \$28.20 per LF; 4" type F conduit = \$6.55 per LF; edge grading = \$1,850.00; maintaining traffic = \$1,300.00; mobilization = \$5,800.00. Total if all parts of the bid are completed = \$310,485.55. Seconded by Mr. Coad. Vote: Mr. Stevenson, yes; Mr. Smith, yes; Mr. Coad, yes. Motion carried.
