- Phil Shaw reported that the Township received one bid for the 2019 Road Repair Project from Small's Asphalt Paving, Inc. The bid is in a per-unit basis as follows: butt joint milling = \$1,600.00 each; tackcoat furnished and applied = \$2.50 per gallon; 411 limestone berm = \$43.85 per ton; MC-3000 sealing = \$3.05 per gallon; #8 limestone sealing = \$36.30 per ton; 441-1 asphalt concrete surface course = \$73.50 per ton; maintaining traffic = \$1,050.00 total for job; mobilization = \$3,800.00 total for job. Total for project = \$180,752.05.
- Resolution 19-18 Mr. Smith moved to accept the bid from Small's Asphalt Paving on a per-unit basis for the 2019 Road Repair Project. Total for project is \$180,752.05. Seconded by Mr. Coad. Vote: Mr. Stevenson, yes; Mr. Smith, yes; Mr. Coad, yes. Motion carried.
