- 1. Terry Banks reported that: the Township's F-550 dump truck, Cat backhoe and Massey-Ferguson mowing tractor all have brake problems; they installed a tile on Gingerhill Road; and holes patched on Peatmoss and Gingerhill Roads.
- 2. Jim Dickson reported that Diewalt's variance was approved by the zoning board of appeals.

Reports:

- 1. Mr. Stevenson reported that he was checking into prices for propane for the 2014-2015 winter heating season. So far CoAlliance is the lowest at \$1.699 per gallon.
- 2. Mr. Stevenson reported that at this time Licking County Recycling has no contractor to handle the tires for the tire collection day July 26th. He is not sure if the date will have to be changed or not.
- 3. Mr. Coad reported that the Township has received the material to crack-seal the Township's roads.

Old Business:

Mr. Stevenson reported that he received the partition fence notification from Mr. & Mrs. John Ogle concerning the partition fence bordering their property and the property of Mr. & Mrs. John Kerber.
