- 2. From the 2023 Road Improvement Project:
- a. Washington Township had 0.88 mile of pavement applied to Smoots Road.
- b. Washington Township had 1.65 miles of chip/seal applied on three roads.
- c. Washington Township had 415 feet of tile installed under two roads.
- d. The cost of pavement, for one mile, at a two-inch depth is over \$120,000.
- e. The cost of chip/seal, for one mile, is over \$31,012.
- f. Washington Township utilized over \$240,726 of Road Levy funds on the roads this year.
- g. In the last ten years, Washington Township has paved over 13.5 miles, chip/sealed 23.74 miles, installed over 1.6 miles of tile and spent over \$1,926,188 of your tax dollars on the 21.408 miles of township roads.
