- 3. Mr. Coad reported that he is having trouble connecting with the Township's email address.
- 4. The Board reported that the Township's salt bin is cleaned out and ready for salt deliveries.

Old Business:

- 1. The Board reported that they received the final bill from Small's Asphalt Paving, Inc. for the 2015 Road Repair Project. The Trustees inspected the bill and approved payment in full.
- 2. The Board discussed the application to OPWC for funding on the Richards Road widening project. After discussion, the Board will postpone the project at this time.

New Business:

- 1. The Board received notice from the Licking County Auditor that the representative from Washington Township to the Tax Incentive Review Council (TIRC) needs to be appointed for 2016-2017. Mr. Coad is the current representative for Washington Township.
