

MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE TRUSTEES OF

WASHINGTON TOWNSHIP

JAN. 11, 1930

Present: Moore, Smoots and Warthen.

The minutes of the last meeting were read and approved.

Motion by Smoots and seconded by Warthen, that we request the County Commissioners to grant the petition of Charles Weaver and others for placing of Road Nos. 75, 167, and 80, on the County Highway System, according to the request of said petition. Carried.

TO THE HONORABLE BOARD OF TOWNSHIP TRUSTEES OF WASHINGTON TOWNSHIP. We the undersigned, residents residing in the immediate vicinity of Township Road Nos. 75, 167 and 80, petition your Honorable Body to take the necessary measures to have the following described roads placed on the County Highway System.

Road No. 75 beginning at the Washington-Newton Township line; thence extending in a short northerly direction to Road. No. 167; thence east on Road No. 167 to the junction of Road Nos. 167 and 76; thence in a northerly direction of Roads 75 and 80 terminating at State Highway No. 337.

Motion by Smoots, seconded by Warthen, that the First National Bank, Utica, Ohio, be Depository for the Township Funds for the coming 2 year period, ending Jan. 1, 1932, the bank to pay interest at the rate of 2.60% annum, computed on the average daily balance, interest to be added semi-annually. The bank to give a \$10,000 Bond. Carried.
