

THE MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF

THE TRUSTEES OF WASHINGTON TOWNSHIP. ✓

JANUARY 9, 1932.

This being the first meeting of the year, the trustees were organized with Reed Moore, A. M. Smoots and Graham Kirkpatrick present.

The bonds of the American Surety Co. for the Trustees were filed and sworn.

Motion by Smoots, seconded by Kirkpatrick that Reed Moore be President of the Board of Trustees for the coming 2 years. Carried.

Motion by Smoots, seconded by Kirkpatrick, that the bond of D. M. Warner, clerk, be approved. Carried.

Bids for Funds were received as follows: First National Bank, 2.50 and Utica Savings Bank 2.40.

Motion by Smoots, seconded by Kirkpatrick, that the First National Bank be depository for the township for the coming two years at it's bid of $3\frac{1}{2}\%$ on a daily average. Bond of \$12,000.00 will be required. Carried.

Motion by Smoots, seconded by Moore, that Eli Mills be hired as Road Superintendent at \$4.00 per day, for the 2 year period. Carried.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned to meet January 16, 1932 at 1. p. m.
