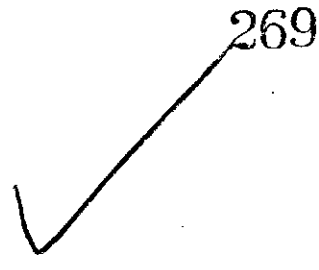


THE MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE TRUSTEES OF WASHINGTON TOWNSHIP.

Road fund	5,000.00

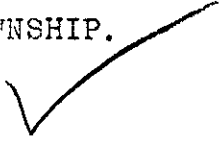
and that we have a public hearing, July 13, 1932 at 7:30 p. m. Carried.
