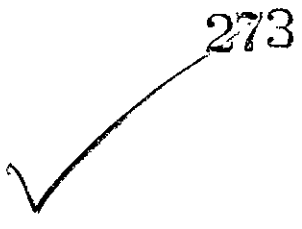


THE MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE
