Dear Sir:

Please read this letter at the next meeting of your township trustees.

We wish to call your attention to the fact that only this office can let labor work on county roads. In the past various trustees have allowed men in their neighborhood to work cutting brush and weeds etc. on the county highway without first securing permission from here, and this considerably messes up the county road program and in a good many cases bills come in here months after work has been performed. As the summer period is about to get under way two or three cases have already come to our attention where work has already been performed with the expectation of having the county pay for the same.

If we expect to perform the duties of this office with any regularity and good judgement such conditions cannot exist.

Therefore if any one in your township approaches a trustee for permission to work on the county highway, you will please refer them to this office. From now on we will not be able to pay for any such work without permission having been secured from this office before the work is done.

If you gentlemen will cooperate with us to this extent we will appreciate the fact very much, and no misunderstandings of the past will occur again.
