This was a Special Meeting called on account of receiving bids on selling old equipment and purchase of one Road maintainer.

After much discussion by the trustees it was decided to not open bids until five days had elapsed after the closing the time for receiving bids as Prosecuting Attorney Kreiger had said we must let the five days pass before accepting any of the offers to buy or sell, in accordance with same the Trustees decided to have meeting on Saturday afternoon October 26th, at two oclock.

W.F.Berger was present with a sheep claim for three sheep killed by dogs, he had two witnesses with him and report was made out to County Commissioners and signed and sworn to by Mr. Berger and the two witnesses and report was mailed to County Commissioners.

Mr. T.S.Hickenbotham was also present and reported two sheep killed by dogs his report was made out and sworn too by himself and two witnesses and same was mailed to County Commissioners.
