Minutes of last meeting read and approved.



Clerk reported receipt of \$ 25.00 received from Thos. Shoosmith in payment of old road grader


The following bills were presented, after examination of same Reynolds made Motion same be allowed and paid, seconded by Warthen, upon call of vote all Members voted " Yes".
