The clerk contacted Jim Holden, The County Engineer and he is going to survey the township property at his convience for the trustees.

Report of trustees meeting on a disputed line fence:

At 9:00 Saturday November 28, 1953 the trustees met at the line fence between Eva Nutter - Ava Paulsen and John W. Woods. Using a 50 foot rule the trustees measured the fence. Starting from south at Woods' place and going north the trustees measured 834 feet to the half way point and 834 feet north of the dividing line. Stanley Walton and Orren Hill represented Eva Nutter - Ava Paulsen and John Woods represented himself. The trustees decided that the south end of the fence belonged to John Woods. The north end of the fence belongs to Eva Nutter - Ava Paulsen. John Woods agreed to buy the dividing post. The post is to be not less than 8 inches across the top. Eva Nutter - Ava Paulsen is to have the dividing post put in. The post is to be a locust post or a ~~XXXX~~ creosoted post. Eva Nutter - Ava Paulsen are to rebuild their fence. John Woods is to repair his end of the fence with new posts where necessary. The fence is to be put in within 30 days. An iron stake was driven in the ground at the halfway point by John Mills a ~~XXXX~~ trustee.

The trustees had a discussion about the line fence mentioned in the previous paragraph.

No other business the meeting was adjourned till December 14, 1953.
