Mr. Loren Briggs, Executive head of the North Fork Local School District, met with the Board of Trustees. After explaining the Schools need for additional playground space near the Junior High School, Mr. Briggs asked that the School be allowed to use the Township lot at the south end of Utica. The lot would be used for a playground for supervised physical education activity during the year 1960. After some discussion, Mr. Wince moved that: The School be allowed to use the Township lot as outlined and that the School would prepare the grounds for suitable use, and that the Township would incur no expense in the preparation or maintenance of same. Mr Jewett seconded the motion. VOTE: Wince-yes; Jewett, Yes; Torrens- Yes. Motion carried.

Mr. Hull, Road Supervisor reported that the roads were open and that School Buses and other traffic was moving. The recent continued snows had created quite a problem and the Trustees were much concerned about the cost of snow removal and control.

The Licking Rural Electrification presented a check made payable to W.T. Moore for the repair of cable damage on road #76. This check was mailed to mr. Moore.
