It also was reported that the Fishbaugh hedge was in the process of being trimmed.

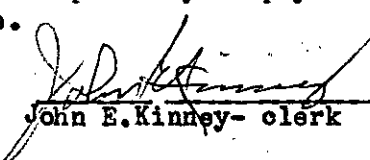
The clerk was instructed to order one load of cinders from Fox Coal Co. of Newark, Ohio.

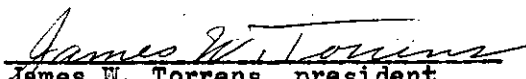

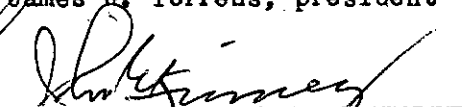
Roll call: Mr. Torrens-yes; Mr.Wince-yes;Mr.Jewett-yes.
