The Washington Township Board of Trustees met at the Township Meeting Place for the purpose of transacting the business of the Township, and organizing for the current year.

The following members were present: Mr. Torrens; Mr. Wince; Mr. Jewett. The meeting was called to order by Mr. Torrens, the outgoing president.

The minutes of the regular meeting Dec. 30, 1960 were read and approved.

Chairmanship was given to Mr. Kinney, the clerk for the purpose of electing a president and vice president.

Nominations being open for ~~for~~ the office of president, Mr. Jewett nominated Mr. Torrens.

Mr. Wince moved the nominations be closed and Mr. Jewett seconded the motion. Roll Call: Mr. Wince-yes; Mr. Jewett-yes. Mr. Torrens-Not voting. The clerk declared Mr. Torrens the duly-elected president and relinquished the chairmanship of the meeting.

Nominations being open for the office of vice-president, Mr. Jewett nominated Mr. Wince. Mr. Torrens moved the nominations be closed; seconded by Mr. Jewett.

Roll Call: Mr. Torrens-yes; Mr. Jewett-yes. Mr. Wince not voting. The president declared Mr. Wince to be the duly-elected vice president.

Motion ~~is~~ was made by Mr. Jewett and seconded by Mr. Wince that the regular meetings of the Washington Township Board of Trustees be held every other Monday evening at 8:00 PM, with the first next meeting to be held on Jan. 9th 1961. Exception to this schedule would be when this day falls on a legal holiday, then the meeting would be held the following evening, unless otherwise scheduled by the board.

Roll Call: Mr. Torrens-yes; Mr. Jewett-yes; Mr. Wince-yes. The president declared the resolution duly adopted.

Upon completion of the business before the board, Mr. Wince moved the meeting be adjourned. Mr. Jewett seconded the motion.

Roll Call: Mr. Wince-yes; Mr. Torrens-yes; Mr. Jewett-yes. The president declared the meeting adjourned.


