The Washington Township Board of Trustees met in regular session in the township office for the purpose of organizing and transacting any other business deemed necessary.

Present: Mr. Torrens; Mr. Wince; Mr. Mills.

Mr. Torrens, the outgoing President presided.  
The minutes of the Dec. 28, 1961 meeting were read and approved.

Certificates of Election were presented by Mr. Wince, re-elected trustee and Mr. Mills, newly elected Trustee, and is hereby made a part of the minute record.

Mr. Wince presented his bond which had been approved by Mr. Henry C. Ashcraft, Probate Judge of Licking County. Mr. Wince also presented his certificate of Oath of Office administered by Henry C. Ashcraft, Probate Judge of Licking County. Mr. Mills presented his Bond which had been approved by Mr. Henry C. Ashcraft, Probate Judge of Licking County. Mr. Mills also presented his certificate of Oath of Office which had been administered by Mr. Harvey Alexander Judge of Municipal Court, Newark, Ohio. These documents are filed in the Township files.

Mr. Torrens appointed Mr. Kinney, the Township clerk, to preside over the meeting for the purpose of election of officers for the year 1962.

The chairman asked for nominations for the office of Board President;.

Mr. Torrens nominated Mr. Wince.

Mr. Wince nominated Mr. Torrens.

Mr. Mills moved that the nominations be closed. Mr. Wince seconded the motion.

Mr. Torrens, receiving the majority of votes, was declared elected President.

The chairman asked for nominations for the office of Vice-President.

Mr. Torrens nominated Mr. Wince. Mr. Mills moved that the nominations be closed.

Mr. Torrens seconded the motion.

Vote: Mr. Torrens-- for Mr. Wince  
Mr. Mills----for Mr. Wince.  
Mr. Wince-- Not voting.

Mr. Wince receiving the majority of votes was declared elected vice-president.

The conduct of the meeting was relinquished to Mr. Torrens the newly elected president.

Mr. Wince moved that the following resolution be adopted:

That the Board of Trustees of Washington Township meet in regular session on Monday January 8, 1962 and every two weeks thereafter. Meeting time to at 8:00 PM in the township office.

Mr. Mills seconded the motion.

The president declared the resolution adopted.

Several items of concern to the Board were discussed and should receive further consideration at future meetings.

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
