

Held January 25, 1962.

The Washington Township Board of Trustees met in SPECIAL session in the Township office for the purpose of opening and considering bids which had been received on furnishing a truck for the township.

Present: Mr. Torrens; Mr. Mills; Mr. Wince.

The minutes of the regular meeting of Jan 22 was suspended till the next regular meeting to be held Feb 5th.

~~Mr. Mills moved that the Board adopt a resolution requesting approval of the~~

County Commissioners for the purchase of a truck and also approval of a deferred payment plan for said truck.

Mr. Wince seconded the motion.

Roll Call: Mr. Mills-yes; Mr. Wince-yes; Mr. Torrens-Yes.

The president declared the resolution adopted.

Bids for furnishing a truck were received from the following suppliers, with all bids to include a five speed transmission :

Mr. Robert Law of Law Chevrolet, Mr. J.J. Wahl of Wahl Motor Sales, and Mr. R.P. Servais of RP Servais GMC were present and each explained certain particulars pertaining to his company's bid. No one was present from Dusty Rhodes Chevrolet.

It was unanimously agreed that the Ford F600 series truck was too lite a truck to be considered and Mr. Wahl was asked to submit a bid for a Ford F700 series truck. After much discussion the meeting was suspended until 12:30 PM Jan. 26th at which time the bid for a F 700 Ford series would be available.

At approximately 12:30 Pm Jan. 26th the Board of Trustees reconvened for further consideration of truck bids. The only change in bidding was the bid from Wahl Motor Sales on a Series F 700 truck and the bid was in the amount of \$4513.00.

After further and final consideration of bids Mr. Mills moved that the Board accept the bid from The Law Chevrolet Co. as follows:

Roll Call: Mr. Wince-yes; Mr. Mills-yes; Mr. Torrens-yes.


The president declared the resolution adopted.
