The Washington Township Board of Trustees met in regular session in the Township office for the purpose of transacting the business of the township.

Present: Mr. Torrens; Mr. Mills; Mr. Wince.

The minutes of the regular meeting held Jan. 22 ~~was~~ and the special meetings held Jan. 25th and Jan 26th were read and approved.

An invoice was presented from Dale Rine, St. Rt., Utica, Ohio to The County Commissioners in amount of \$250.00 for cutting and burning eight dead elm trees ~~in~~ along old Route 62 west of Utica. On motion by Mr. Wince and seconded by Mr. Mills this bill was approved and forwarded to the County Commissioners.

The meeting time was reconsidered and Mr. Wince moved that during the balance of the winter months and until any future change that the time of meeting of the Board be changed from 8:00 PM to 7:30 Pm. Mr. Mills seconded the motion. Vote: Mr. Wince-yes; Mr. Mills-yes; Mr. Torrens- Yes. The president declared the resolution adopted.

A truck having been purchased for the township, the Trustees considered the matter of a snow plow for use with the truck. Having received information from plow companies Mr. Mills moved that a plow be purchased from The Gledhill Road Mchy. Co., Galion, Ohio thru its representative Mr. John G. Carlisle, Rt. 5, Columbus, Ohio and to be described as follows:

Mr. Wince seconded the motion .
