The Washington Township Board of Trustees met in regular session in the Township Office for the purpose of transacting the business of the township.


Present: Mr. Torrens; Mr. Wince; Mr. Mills.

Roll Call: Mr. Torrens- Yes; Mr. Wince- Yes; Mr. Mills- Yes.


The president ~~mix~~ declared the motion carried.


On discussing the high water of March 4th it was reported that there was three and one half feet of water in the township garage. The equipment had been moved from the garage and the damage was slight.
