The Washington Township Board of Trustees met in regular session in the Township office for the purpose of transacting the business of the Township.


Present were trustees: Mr. Torrens, Mr. Wince and Mr. Mills.

Mr. Mills moved that the above bills be approved as lawful obligations of the Township and that the clerk be directed to issue warrants of the Township in payment of same.


Mr. Wince seconded the motion.
