Present were James W. Torrens, George F. Wince and Jack T. Londot, Trustees and the Clerk, Neil D. Reeder.

Mr. Torrens the outgoing President, opened the meeting and the minutes of the meeting of December 27, 1965 were read and approved.

The meeting was turned over to the New President.


Mr. Wince moved the adoption of the following resolution:

The Auditor of State respectfully requests an early return of this report to the County Auditor, not later than January 10 and will highly appreciate the cooperation of the various officials to this end in order to assist him in carrying out the provisions of law.
