Present for the meeting were Trustees: James W. Torrens, George F. Wince, and Jack T. Londot.

The minutes of the meeting of January 1, 1966 were read and approved.


Mr. Wince moved the adoption of the following resolution:


That Myers W. Hull be hired as Road Superintendent for the year 1966 at salary of \$2.50 per hour and that he also be allowed fifty (50) hours (\$125.) vacation pay for the year. Also, that all hired labor be paid at the hourly rat of \$1.75 per hour for the year 1966. Mr. Londot seconded the motion. Vote. Mr. Torrens, yea; Mr. Wince, yea; Mr. Londot, yea; President declared the motion adopted.

Mr. Wince moved and Mr. Londot seconded the motion that the Trustees and Clerk be allowed all necessary expenses including milage at ten cents per mile, garage rent, room and meals and registration fees while attending Trustees and Clerk Convention in Columbus, Ohio, January 19 - 22, 1966. President declared the motion adopted.

The necessary papers for the annual appropriation have not been received, therefore appropriations will be made at the next meeting January 17, 1966.

Meeting adjourned on motion of Mr. Londot and seconded of Mr. Wince.
