The Washington Township Board of Trustees met in regular session this date for the purpose of transacting the business of the Township.

Present for the meeting were: Mr. Torrens; Mr. Wince- Mr. Londot; Mr. Kinney and Mr. Hull.

The minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

In the interest of safety and security Mr. Londot moved that flasher lights be installed on the road grader and that they be not less than four inch size. Mr. Wince seconded the motion.
