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The Washington Township Board of Trustees met in regular session this date for the purpose of transacting the business of the township.

Present for the meeting were: Mr. Torrens; Mr. Wince; Mr. Londot; Mr. Kinney and Mr. Hull.

Mr. Daniel E. Helpfrey, member of the Executive Committee of The Licking county Regional Planning Commission appeared prior the meeting and distributed Land Use Plan, Regional Report No. 5.

The minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

Mr. Hull reported that the security light at the junction of Co.200 and Twp.206 was out and the clerk was directed to notify the Licking rural Electrification.

Mr. Wince reported that there was a tree down on Twp.76 about 1/4 mile south of Twp. Rd. 80. Mr. Hull was instructed to dispose of same.

New rates as applied to Township employees were received from P.E.R.S. and were noted to be effective as of July 1, 1968. The new rate is to be 7.7% .

Rates affecting employer for 1969 are: First six months the rate will continue at the present 8%. The last six months the rate will be 9.3%.
