The Washington Township Board of Trustees met in regular session this date for the purpose of transacting the business of the township.

Present for the meeting were*-Mr. Torrens; Mr. Wince; Mr. Londot; Mr. Kinney and Mr. Hull.

The minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

A Memo from the County Prosecuting Attorney outlining sellers legal obligation when purchase of real estate is made by a Political Sub-division was noted and filed.

A Memo from the Ohio Dept. of Highways concerning the approval of Building Permits as applied to those authorities having zoning was noted and filed.

There was considerable discussion concerning road, culvert and ditch conditions due to a continued period of rainfall.

Damage was determined to be mostly minor at any one location and that some culverts should be replaced and ditches cleaned of excess debris and soil which had washed in.
