The Washington Township Board of Trustees met in regular session this date for the purpose of transacting the business of the township.

Present for the meeting were: Mr. Torrens, Mr. Wince, Mr. Londot, Mr. Kinney and Mr. Hull.

The minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

The proposed 1969 budget of The Licking County Regional Planning Commission was received, noted and filed. The 1969 fee for the Township was noted to be \$155.00.

The Local Government Tax Revision in Ohio as proposed by a Research Report by The Battelle Institute was briefly discussed and filed. The Board believed that it was too soon to ~~take~~ express an opinion on the matter.

Work on the 1969 Township Budget was scheduled for the June 24th meeting, with the hearing on same to be July 8th 1968. The hearing notice was scheduled to appear in the June 27 issue of the local paper.

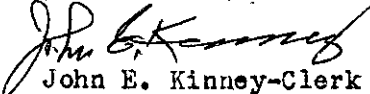
Mr. Wince moved that the preceding bills be approved as lawful obligations of Washington Township and that the clerk be directed to issue warrants of the township in payment of same.

Roll call Vote: Mr. Torrens-Yes; Mr. Wince-Yes; Mr. Londot- Yes.

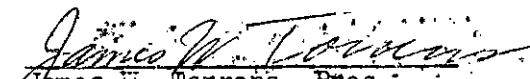
The president declared the motion approved.

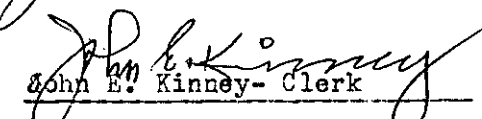
I certify that there are sufficient funds in the depository to pay the above bills and that checks have been issued in payment of same.
