The Washington Township Board of Trustees met in regular session this date for the purpose of transacting the business of the township.

Present for the meeting were: Mr. Torrens; Mr. Wince; Mr. Londot; Mr. Kinney; Mr. Hull.

The minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

The Township budget for the year 1969 was prepared in tentative form and made ready for the Budget hearing meeting which had been scheduled for Monday evening July 8, 1968 at eight o'clock.

By mutual agreement a Zoning meeting with the Licking County Regional Planning Director was scheduled for Friday evening June 28, 1968 at 8:00 PM.

It was reported that the Village of Utica had closed its facility for refuse disposal to residents living outside the Village limits. This situation was recognized as an inconvenience to Township residents living near the Village and who had previously had access to the disposal. Several possibilities were discussed, but none seemed to be acceptable. The Board was more or less favorable toward a cooperative effort with other agencies having the common problem providing the cost could be determined on a population basis. No action was taken pending further study.
