The Washington Township Board of Trustees met in regular session this date for the purpose of transacting the business of the township.

Present for the meeting were: Mr. Torrens; Mr. Wince; Mr. Londot; Mr. Kinney and Mr. Hull.

The minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

The Fire Contract with the Utica Volunteer Fire Dept., which had been postponed at the Aug. 19th meeting, was presented for action by the Board.

Mr. Londot moved that the Fire Contract, to be in effect from August 24, 1968 to August 24th, 1971 be accepted.

Mr. Wince seconded the motion.

Roll call vote: Mr. Torrens-yes; Mr. Wince-Yes; Mr. Londot-Yes.

The president declared the motion approved.

The board discussed various conditions existing in the township and instructed the clerk to write letters to the following township residents:


Mr. Wince moved that the preceding bills be allowed as lawful obligations of Washington Township and that the clerk be directed to issue warrants of the township in payment of same.

The president declared the motion approved.


I certify that there are sufficient funds in the depository to pay the above bills and that checks have been issued in payment of same.
