The Washington Township Board of Trustees met in regular session this date for the purpose of transacting the business of the township.

Present for the meeting were: Mr. Torrens; Mr. Wince; Mr. Londot; Mr. Kinney

Mr. Hull; Mr. Dick Van Wey; Mr. Emil Kielbasa.

The minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

With reference to exemption from taxation on publicly owned property, the Bureau of Inspection urged that all political subdivisions owning real property which is used exclusively for public purposes make certain that this property be on the tax exempt list.

The clerk was instructed to contact the County Auditors office for this determination and to follow thru toward having the township real property placed on the tax exempt list, if not presently so listed.

Mr. Emil Kielbasa, counselor for The Continental Casualty Co. explained his company's group insurance coverage. After many questions and answers, Mr. Wince moved the adoption of the following resolution:

As permitted under HB 586, Sect. 505.60 dated Aug. 25, 1967, that Washington Township provide group insurance coverage for Township officers and employees and their immediate dependents, and that, the cost of this coverage be paid by Washington Township, and that, the policy and/or policies of coverage be provided by The Continental Casualty Co., and that, Mr. Kielbasa take applications for same from each individual, and that, the payment be made for the first quarter of coverage at a cost of \$269.25, with additional quarters of coverage at a cost of \$239.25 or at a slightly reduced rate if paid annually.

Mr. Londot seconded the motion and the vote resulted as follows:

Mr. Torrens-Yes; Mr. Wince- Yes; Mr. Londot-Yes.

The president declared the resolution duly adopted.


Dear Mr. Buchanan:

"The Bureau of Inspection and Supervision of Public Offices urges all political subdivisions owning real property, being used exclusively for public purposes, but which has not been placed on the tax exempt list by order of the board of tax appeals, to make proper application for exemption and the remission of all delinquent taxes, penalties, and interest thereon, before December 31, 1968"
