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The Washington Township Board of Trustees met in regular session this date for the purpose of transacting the business of the township. Due to absence of president, meeting was in charge of Vice-Pres. Mr. Londot. Present for the meeting were: Mr. Wince; Mr. Londot; Mr. Kinney and Mr. Hull.

A letter from the Licking County Prosecuting Attorney re the Utica Village income tax, indicating that all officials and employees of the township were liable for payment of the tax, was read and is made a part of the minutes.

The condition of bridges was discussed and it was the opinion of the Trustees present that, all bridges on Washington Township roads should be inspected and a report forwarded to the County Engineer.
