The Washington Township Board of Trustees met in regular session this date for the purpose of transacting the business of the township/.

Present: Mr. Torrens; Mr. Wince; Mr. Londot; Mr. Kinney; Mr. Hull; Mr. John Sanders and Mr. Owen Weaver.

The minutes of the Mar. 10 meeting were read and approved.

Mr. Sanders appeared before the Board with Columbia Dust Layer prices and conditions for application on gravel roads. The Board did not contract for any road treatment at this time. It was generally considered that salt water brine treatment from a local applicator would be acceptable and at a possible lower cost per mile.

Mr. Weaver, a Utica resident living east of and near to the Township lot inquired as to who was responsible for the cutting and cleaning of land which was adjacent to the township lot. Since this land was within the Village limits, the Board suggested that he contact the the village on the matter.

Dumping of refuse along township roads was again becoming a problem, even though the Village does allow residents of the Township to use the village dump.


Mr. Wince moved that the preceding bills be allowed as lawful obligations of Washington Township and that the clerk be directed to issue warrants of the township in payment of same.

The president declared the motion approved.


I certify that there are sufficient funds in the depository to pay the above bills and that checks have been issued in payment of same.
