The Washington Township Board of trustees met in regular session this date for the purpose of transacting the business of the township.

Present were: Mr. Torrens; Mr. Wince; Mr. Londot; Mr. Kinney and Mr. Hull.

The minutes of the March 24th meeting were read and approved.

All of the Trustees and the Clerk were in attendance at the Township Zoning Hearing which was held March 27th. Mr. Skinner of the County Planning Commission was also present. No township residents or others appeared at the meeting.

On motion by Mr. Londot and second by Mr. Wince the time of Board meetings is hereby changed from 7:30 PM to 8:00 pm.

Due to one policyholder not meeting medical requirements, the quarterly rate of premium on the Group Insurance was increased in the amount of \$11.20. Mr. Wince moved that this increase be accepted and payment made accordingly.
