The Washington Township Board of Trustees met in regular session this date for the purpose of transacting the business of the township.

Mr. Torrens announced that he, as president of the County Organization of Township Trustees and Clerks Association, and one or two other members would attend a Solid Waste Program in Columbus, Ohio May 22, 1969 covering Ohio's Waste Disposal Law.

It seemed that information to be gained from this meeting could be valuable toward any future procedure for the Township in it's responsibility to the Township residents concerning waste disposal.


Mr. Wince moved that the preceding bills be allowed as lawful obligations of Washington township and that the clerk be directed to issue warrants of the township in payment of same.
