The Board of Trustees of Washington Township met in regular session this date for the purpose of transacting the business of the Township.

Present for the meeting Were: Mr. Torrens; Mr. Winow; Mr. Londot; Mr. Kinney
Mr. Hull and Mr. Marvin Snyder.

The minutes of the May 19 meeting were read and approved.

Mr. Torrens and Mr. Kinney had attended a Solid Waste Disposal Program in Columbus on May 22 and reported that the information gained would be very helpful in the future County and Township waste disposal problems.

Mr. Torrens announced that at a called meeting of Township Trustees and Village Mayors of Licking County, the Group approved a "Resolution requesting the Licking County Board of Commissioners to create a County wide Solid Waste Disposal District". This action was considered as a first step toward compliance with the Ohio Waste Disposal Law.

The Clerk reported that Zoning Resolution and Map had been presented to the County Board of Elections toward having the issue placed on the ballot at the November 4, 1969 election.

Mr. Snyder quoted a price of 17¢ per gallon for application of weed control chemicals along township highways. The Board agreed to spray only as considered necessary.

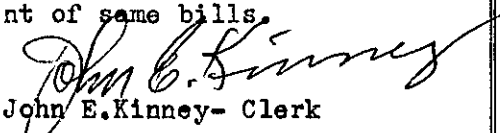
Mr. Wince moved that the preceding bills be allowed as lawful obligation of Washington Township and that the clerk be directed to issue warrants of the township in payment of same.
