The Board of Trustees of Washington Township met in regular session this date for the purpose of transacting the business of the township.

Present for the meeting were: Mr. Torrens; Mr. Wince; Mr. Londot; Mr. Kinney and Mr. Hull.

The minutes of the June 2nd meeting were read and approved.

The Board discussed with the road supt. the matter of spraying certain parts of the various roads which should or should not be treated with weed and brush control chemicals.

The need for mowing along highways was considered and determined that mowing should start as soon as someone could be hired to operate the equipment.

Forms for the 1970 budget had been received and the Board agreed that a Special meeting should be held for the preparation of the budget, the date to be determined later.

Mr. Wince moved that the Budget hearing date be at the regular meeting on July 14, 1969, and that, the Clerk place a Public Hearing Notice in the local newspaper announcing same.

Mr. Londot seconded the motion.
