The Washington Township Board of Trustees met in regular session this date for the purpose of transacting the business of the township.

Present for the meeting were: Mr. Torrens; Mr. Wince; Mr. Londot; Mr. Kinney; Mr. Hull and Mr. Marvin Snyder.

The minutes of the June 30 meeting were read and approved.

This meeting date had been advertised as a time for a Hearing on the 1970 Budget. No Township residents were in appearance in connection with the Budget.

Mr. Wince moved the adoption of the following resolution:

That the 1970 Budget, as prepared, be accepted and forwarded to the County Auditor.

Mr. Londot seconded the motion.

Roll call vote was as follows: Mr. Torrens-Yes; Mr. Wince-Yes; Mr. Londot-Yes. The president declared the resolution adopted.

Mr. Marvin Snyder, having applied weed killer along roads, asked the Board's opinion as to results. The "kill" was reported as satisfactory.

Twp. Rd. 76 along creek was reported as badly undercut and washed. Further inspection was scheduled, and if found to be necessary, a contractor would have to be hired to install cribbing along creek bank.
