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The Washington Township Board of Trustees met in regular session this date for the purpose of transacting the business of the township.

Present for the meeting were: Mt. Torrens; Mr. Wince; Mr. Londot; Mr. Kinney; Mr. Hull.

The minutes of the Oct. 6th meeting were read and approved.

With reference to the State tax of seven (7) cents per gallon being currently included in the rate paid for diesel fuel, the Board determined that this tax should be pro rated for refund purposes on the basis of 95% used in grading roads and 5% used on highways. The clerk was instructed to use this formula in making application for tax refund.

Mr. Londot reported that he had contacted The Newark Asphalt Co. in regard to blacktopping road intersections. This Company informed him that should weather conditions permit, they could possibly complete two applications yet this fall. The Trustees would be contacted prior to starting this work.

In order that fire calls from Township residents could be more efficiently made, the Board asked the clerk to contact the Fire Dept. and try to get 'fire phone number stickers' for phones in the township.
