The Washington Township Board of Trustees met in regular session this date for the purpose of transacting the business of the Township.

Present were: Mr. Torrens; Mr. Wince; Mr. Londot; Mr. Kinney; Mr. Hull and Mr. Dan Helpfrey.

The minutes of the meeting of Feby. 23 were read and approved.

Mr. Dan Helpfrey appeared before the Board concerning compensation for his services as Washington Township Zoning Inspector. He asked that he be allowed mileage only at this time.

Mr. Londot moved that Mr. Helpfrey be allowed mileage at ten cents (10¢) per mile for travel as Zoning Inspector for the Township, and that, should the work load increase in the future, that he again appear before the Board in order that further compensation could be determined.

Mr. Wince seconded the motion.

Roll call vote: Mr. Torrens-Yes; Mr. Wince-Yes; Mr. Londot-Yes.

The president declared the motion approved.

Due to there being other trucks of the same type and color as the Township truck in the area, the Township truck is not easily distinguished. In view of this, Mr. Torrens and Mr. Londot were to investigate the available types of name plates for the truck so that the name would not have to be painted on.

The condition of Township road signs was a matter of discussion by the Board. ~~Some signs~~ Paint was peeling from some signs and it was not readily determined what was causing this. No action was taken pending further consideration.


Mr. Wince moved that the preceding bills be allowed as lawful obligations of Washington Township and that the clerk be directed to issue warrants of the Township in payment of same.

The president declared the motion approved.


I certify that there are sufficient funds in the depository to pay the above bills and that checks have been issued in payment of same.
