The Washington Township Board of Trustees met in regular session this date for the purpose of transacting the business of the township.

Present for the meeting were: Mr. Torrens; Mr. Wince; Mr. Londot; Mr. Kinney and Mr. Hull.

The minutes of the March 23rd meeting were read and approved.

During the winter months there had been quite a lot of refuse deposited along the Township roads. The Board recognized that this situation was something that was very difficult to handle.
