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The Washington Township Board of Trustees met in regular session this date for the purpose of transacting the business of the township.

Present were: Mr. Torrens; Mr. Wince; Mr. Londot; Mr. Kinney; Mr. Hull & Mr. M. Snyder.

The Minutes of the April 6th meeting were read and approved.

Emergency ambulance and first aid service for the Township was discussed. Law & Sons, local undertaker, was presently responding to calls. However, they had indicated that they would prefer that this service be provided by others. The Newark Ambulance Service would be available on call, also the Newark Township Rescue Service would respond on call provided the Township would guarantee payment for calls. No action was taken by the Board at this time.

Mr. Marvin Snyder, spraying contractor, appeared before the Board concerning the spraying of township highways for weed and brush control. The opinion of the Trustees was that only spotted application would be needed this season. Mr. Snyder was informed that he would be contacted as the need could be determined.
