The Washington Township Board of Trustees met in regular session this date for the purpose of transacting the business of the township.

Present were: Mr. Torrens; Mr. Wince; Mr. Londot; Mr. Kinney and Mr. Hull.

The minutes of the July 13th meeting were read and approved.

The summer convention of The Association of Township Trustees and Clerks was scheduled to be held in Toledo, Ohio Aug. 5 to 8, 1970.

Mr. Londot moved that: Officials of Washington Township in attendance be allowed necessary expenses to include: Room and board, mileage at ten cents per mile and garage at cost.

Mr. Wince seconded the motion.

Vote: Mr. Torrens-Yes; Mr. Wince-Yes; Mr. Londot-Yes.

The president declared the motion approved.

Mr. Torrens read a letter from the Licking County Board of Health stating that the Utica Village dump was in violation of the State Solid Waste Law, and that the Village and Washington Township should make every effort to provide a Sanitary Landfill for the area.

The Trustees were in agreement that the Township garage should be painted completely on the outside. The President appointed Mr. Wince to ~~xxxxxx~~ have the garage painted, sidewalls to be white and the roof aluminum.
