The Washington Township Board of Trustees met in regular session this date for the purpose of transacting the business of the township.

Present were: Mr. Torrens; Mr. Wince; Mr. Londot; Mr. Kinney and Mr. Hull.

The minutes of the Aug. 10th meeting were read and approved.

Notice had been received from ~~the~~ State Examiner Mr. Albert W. Knicely that a review of the audit and examination of Washington Township records would be at the examiners office Aug. 27, 1970 at 9:00 AM.

The Board and Clerk agreed that they all would attend this review.

The Board received notice that it could appear before the Licking County Budget Commission on Aug. 27th at 1:00 PM. The Board and Clerk agreed to attend this meeting in support of the 1971 Budget.

Mr. Hull reported that highway mowing should be completed within the next week or ten days.

The Clerk had received from the Township Zoning Inspector an application for permit from The Dry Creek Sand & Gravel Co. which had been allowed by the Board of Zoning Appeals. A Bond in amount of \$10,000.00 was also received.

A suitable location for a Landfill Operation had been found and there seemed to be quite a little opposition from the area concerning the matter. Whether or not this opposition could be overcome was the problem for the Board.
