

# RECORD OF PROCEEDINGS

Minutes of The Board of Trustees of Washington Township

The Washington Township Board of Trustees met in regular session this date for the purpose of transacting the business of the Township.

Present were: Mr. Torrens; Mr. Wince; Mr. Londot and Mr. Kinney.

The meeting date had been changed from Sept. 7th to Sept. 8th due to Labor Day.

The minutes of the August 24th meeting were read and approved.

The Board and Clerk had attended the review of the Township Audit and Examination and the Budget Commission Hearing. Both of these meetings were considered to be helpful and satisfactory.

A report had been received from the County Engineer's Office listing the Road Width of various roads as available. Some roads had no record as to width. In order to have a right-of-way width of all roads, the Board decided to check with the County Engineer for information on the method of having right-of-way width established for the roads without record.

Heavy rainfall had recently hit the area and the Trustees expressed the need to have all ditches cleaned and made ready for the winter months.

In order to avoid washing and to hold road grade certain areas of Township roads were in need of asphalt paving and the following individual jobs were selected to be done this year:

- 1- Twp Rd. #205 north of County Rd. #200:  
Mr. Wince moved that The Newark Asphalt Co. be contracted with to Clean & Tack, Patch and Pave with  $1\frac{1}{2}$  inch asphalt, 187 sq yd at cost \$340.00  
Mr. Londot seconded the motion.  
Vote: Mr. Torrens-Yes; Mr. Wince-Yes; Mr. Londot-Yes.  
The president declared the motion approved.
- 2- Twp Rd. #206 north of County Rd. 200:  
Mr. Wince moved that the Newark Asphalt Co. be contracted with to Clean & Tack, Patch and Pave with  $1\frac{1}{2}$  inch asphalt, 528 SqYd Cost \$660.00  
Mr. Londot seconded the motion.  
Vote: Mr. Torrens-Yes; Mr. Wince-Yes; Mr. Londot- Yes.  
The president declared the motion approved.
- 3- Twp Rd #206 south of County Rd. #200:  
Mr. Londot moved that the Newark Asphalt Co. be contracted with to Clean & Tack, Patch and Pave with 2 inch asphalt, 610 Sq Yd Cost \$980.00  
Mr. Wince seconded the motion.  
Vote: Mr. Torrens-Yes; Mr. Wince-Yes; Mr. Londot-Yes.  
The president declared the motion approved.
- 4- Twp Rd #206 north of County Rd. #165:  
Mr. Londot moved that the Newark Asphalt Co. be contracted with to Clean & Tack, Patch and Pave with  $1\frac{1}{2}$  inch asphalt, 520 SqYd cost \$735.00  
Mr. Wince seconded the motion.  
Vote: Mr. Torrens-Yes; Mr. Wince- Yes; Mr. Londot-Yes.  
The president declared the motion approved.
- 5- Twp. Rd. #205 north of County Rd. #165:  
Mr. Londot moved that the Newark Asphalt Co. be contracted with to Clean & Tack, Patch and Pave with  $1\frac{1}{2}$  inch asphalt, Cost \$258.00  
Mr. Wince seconded the motion.  
Vote: Mr. Torrens-Yes; Mr. Wince-Yes; Mr. Londot-Yes.  
The president declared the motion approved.
- 6- Twp. Rd. #206 # 23 east of Twp Rd #206:  
Mr. Wince moved that the Newark Asphalt Co. be contracted with to Clean & Tack, Patch and Pave with  $1\frac{1}{2}$  inch asphalt, 600 S.Y. Cost \$780.00  
Mr. Londot seconded the motion.  
Vote: Mr. Torrens- Yes; Mr. Wince-Yes; Mr. Londot-Yes.  
The president declared the motion approved.


Mr. Londot moved that the preceeding bills be allowed as lawful obligations of Washington Township and that the clerk be directed to issue warrants of the township in payment of same.

Roll call vote: Mr. Torrens-Yes; Mr. Wince-Yes; Mr. Londot-Yes.


The president declared the motion approved.


I certify that there are sufficient funds in the depository to pay the above bills and that checks have been issued in payment of same.


