The Washington Township Board of Trustees met in regular session this date for the purpose of transacting the business of the Township.

Present were: Mr. Torrens; Mr. Wince; Mr. Londot; Mr. Kinney; Mr. Hull and Mr. John Carlisle.

The minutes of the Oct. 23rd. meeting were read and approved.

Due to Employer Contributions - Retirement charges being greater than the balance in the appropriation, Mr. Wince moved that the sum of forty dollars (\$40.00) be transferred from Gas Fund 3A10 to Gas Fund 3A2.

Mr. Londot seconded the motion.

The president declared the motion approved.

President Torrens reminded those present that the Motor Grader bid opening date was Wed. Nov. 4 at 8:00 PM.

The president declared the motion approved.






There being no further business before the Board, Mr. Londot moved that the meeting be adjourned. Mr. Wince seconded the motion.
