The Washington Township Board of Trustees met in regular session this date for the purpose of transacting the business of the Township.

Present were: Mr. Wince; Mr. Londot; Mr. Kinney; Mr. Hull; Mr. Stanley Walton; Mr. Mahlon Eash and Mr. Eli Miller.

The minutes of the Nov. 30th meeting were read and approved.

Mr. Stanley Walton, Route 1, Utica, Ohio appeared before the Board to file a sheep claim. His witnesses were Mr. Mahlon Eash and Mr. Eli Miller.

The claim for loss of sheep due to being killed and damaged by dogs was processed and presented to Mr. Walton for further disposition.

Due to Appropriation Gas Fund 3B3, Contracts, being insufficient to cover charges, Mr. Wince moved that the sum of One thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) be transferred from Gas Fund 3A4 to Gas Fund 3B3.

Mr. Londot seconded the motion.

Roll call vote: Mr. Wince- Yes; Mr. Londot-Yes.


The Vice president declared the motion approved.


I certify that there are sufficient funds in the depository to pay the above bills and that checks have been issued in payment of same.
